Zone Artist – odd-numbered years ONLY (A.R.C.T. & up) \$75.00
(Minimum Time – 30 minutes, Maximum Time – 45 minutes)

Young Artist – even-numbered years ONLY (A.R.C.T. & up) \$75.00
(Minimum Time – 30 minutes, Maximum Time – 45 minutes)

6. CONTEMPORARY SHOWCASE: For those seeking to qualify for **BRANCH COMPETITIONS ONLY** the following ORMTA fees should be added to the Contemporary Showcase case entry form to register for and obtain an ORMTA Assessment mark. Since Contemporary Showcase is a non-competitive festival, ORMTA Assessment marks will be forwarded to teachers after the festival.
